



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Lessons Learned

- 1. Develop curriculum with host nations

- 6. Fine line between pushing a product and genuinely helping
- 7. Know your purpose and why you are doing what you are doing
- 8. Assemble a team with common interests and goals for infrastructure
- 9. Strategically advise using DIB principles rather than deliver "plug and play."
